"Good feng shui at waterfront Sham Wan Towers" -Kerby Kuek

Many people are skeptical about feng shui, but Kerby Kuek is a believer. The husband of an SHKP Club member said he recently bought a flat in Sham Wan Towers in part because of the project's favourable feng shui.

Worth the price

People are willing to pay for what's important to them. Mr Kuek is a long-time resident of Aberdeen, and the good feng shui at Sham Wan Towers led him to wait two years for the project to go on sale. He checked the price of the development with his estate agent when the property was still under construction, and said, "It was a bit more expensive than other properties, but I bought it anyway, because it has such good feng shui."

Water and fortune

Water is an important element in feng shui, Mr Kuek said, adding proximity to water is a big plus for Sham Wan Towers. He said being

on the south of Hong Kong Island facing Sham Wan Bay is beneficial for the project because the water in front flows from northwest to southeast. This movement is essential to good feng shui, signifying 'fortune'. Facing the yacht club where many boats are moored also adds fortune to the development, because boats imply an accumulation of wealth. Mr Kuek said the breakwaters down Po Chong Wan and Tai Shue Wan contribute even more fortune.

Good for career

Mr Kuek said the Chinese name for Sham Wan Towers is also auspicious according to

another aspect of feng shui, since it has 48 strokes. This is good for people working as consultants and advisors. He also said that 2004 begins the eighth cycle of fortune, which also is favourable to people working in consultancy or social work. Mr Kuek is a securities consultant and his wife a social worker. He added that the south-facing orientation of Sham Wan Towers means perennial prosperity according to feng shui rules.

More reasons

Mr Kuek stressed that feng shui is something very personal. He didn't believe in the idea years ago, but was gradually drawn to the theory and began to learn more about it. He stressed that there were many other reasons for choosing Sham Wan Towers, such as the developer's reputation and the fact that most of his family live in Aberdeen. "Sham Wan Towers was an ideal choice for me in so many ways," Mr Kuek said.
