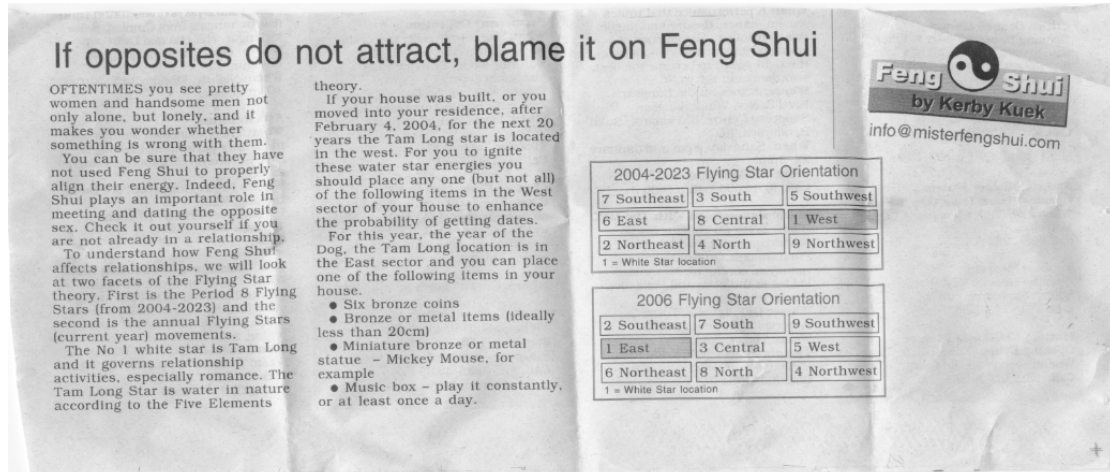

If opposites do *not* attract, blame it on Feng Shui!



Oftentimes you see pretty women and handsome men not only alone, but lonely, and it makes you wonder whether something is wrong with them! You can be sure that they have not used Feng Shui to properly align their energy. Indeed, Feng Shui plays an important role in meeting and dating the opposite sex. Check it out yourself if you are not in a relationship!

To understand how Feng Shui affects relationships, we will look at two facets of the Flying Star theory. First is the Period 8 Flying Stars (from 2004-2023) and the second is the annual Flying Stars (current year) movements. The number 1 white star is Tam Long (貪狼) and it governs relationship activities, especially romance related. This Tam Long Star is water-in-nature according to the Five Elements theory.

If your house was built, or you moved into your residence, after February 4, 2004, for the next twenty years the Tam Long star is located in the west. For you to ignite these water star energies you should place **any one** (but not all) of the following items in the **West sector** of your house to enhance the probability of getting dates. For the year of the Dog, 2006, the Tam Long location is in the **East sector** and for current year 2005, the star is located **Southwest sector**, you can either following items.

1. Six bronze coins

2. Bronze or metal items (ideally less than 8 inches long), Miniature bronze or metal statue (i.e., Mickey mouse, etc.
3. Music box - play it constantly, or at least once a day
