

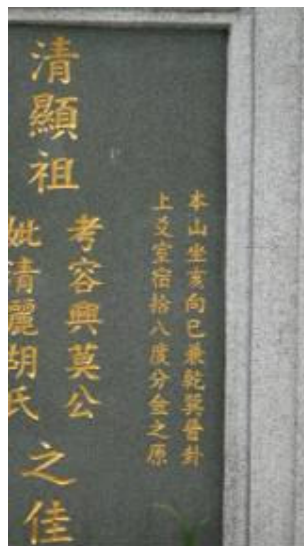


Date: May 28th 9am

The interesting left side view of the site (右虎)



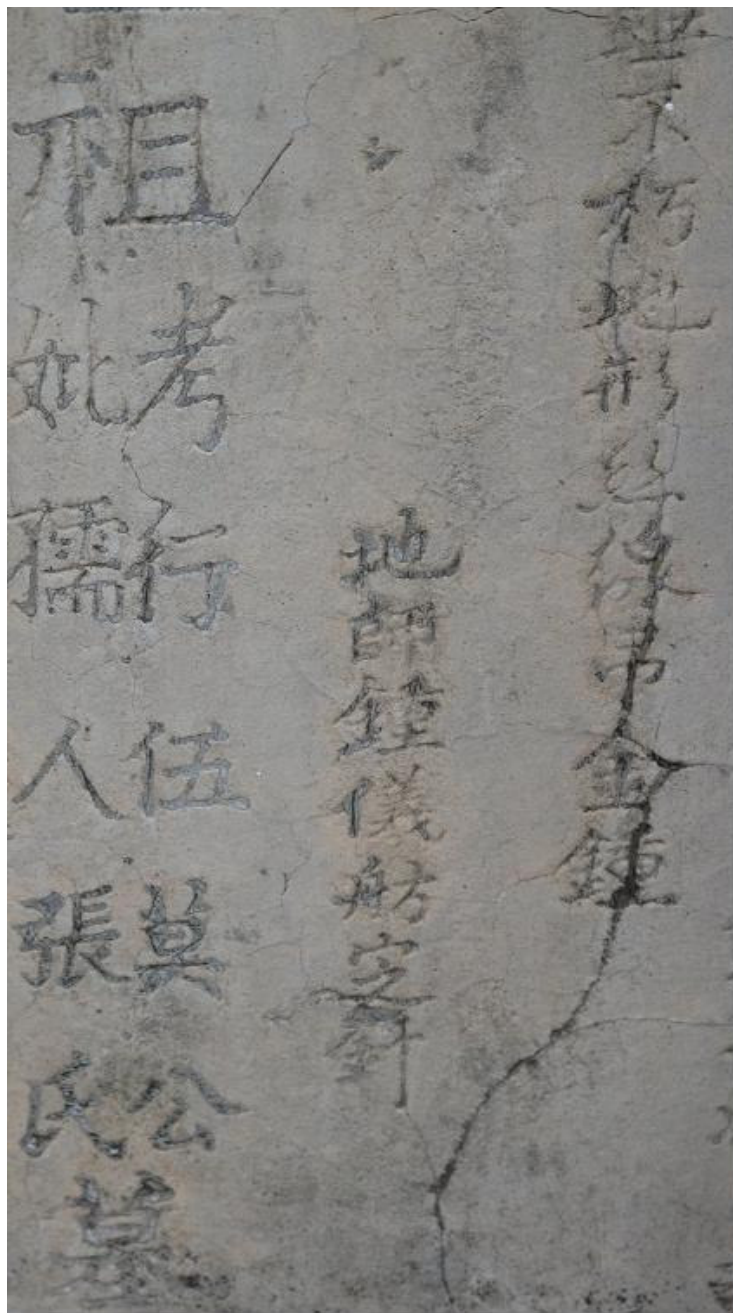
The frontier view of the site, obviously modern building has bad impact for the tomb.
